## Instructions for preparation of seminar paper At course: Distribution and industrial networks

Seminar has two parts: written paper, which you hand over in electronic form (.doc or .pdf) and oral presentation in a classroom.

You can choose the topic of the seminar paper from the list of topics, published on subject homepage (<u>http://lrf.fe.uni-lj.si</u>). Before starting with your work, you should check if the topic is still available and confirm your choice on Doodle pool – you will find link on the subject web page (<u>http://lrf.fe.uni-lj.si</u>).

Seminar paper needs to cover the topic in good details and should provide you with enough material to be able to prepare an oral presentation lasting 15 minutes. It should be written in good English, understandable and with not many grammatical and typographical errors. It is desirable that the seminar paper also include certain images, graphs, equations ... to facilitate the understanding of the material.

At the end of the seminar paper some 3 to 5 questions from the seminar topic need to be listed together with right answers. Questions should be followed by a homework task also from the topic of the seminar which one can do in 10 to 15 minutes. The example of the "solution" should be provided also.

Oral presentation will be carried out within the framework of lectures. Presentation should be 15 minutes long and you can use additional time (around 5 minutes) to present the homework and the way how it should be done. You should use MS Power Point file or similar presentation tool for your presentations. In the presentation you should cover the topic as complete as possible and present it in a meaningful way. Presentation will be followed by questions from professor and fellow students.

The schedule for the presentations is published together with topics. Time of lectures and classroom are published on a faculty schedule.
